



DOT'S RESTAURANT

ARCHITECTURE, ENGINEERING, HISTORIC RENOVATION | Wilmington, VT

Dot's Restaurant was among those buildings very badly damaged in Hurricane Irene. Stevens & Associates led the stabilization of the existing structure and designed the renovations, providing architectural services as well as structural and civil engineering.

It was necessary to remove the existing building in pieces to rebuild the foundation, which needed to be fully replaced and flood-proofed.

The renovations also included expanding the original kitchen, and creating an innovative overhang design to provide a spacious dining area cantilevered over the river, although the total number of seats remained the same.
